Cleon Township & Cleon Fire Dept News

The Cleon Township Board is exploring the possibility of a new fire station and Township offices. The present building structure was built in the 1960's and various items are reaching the end of their life. An assessment was done by APEX Engineering and economically it would take a lot of money to fixing it up and it would still be an old pole building, so the recommendation was to determine a potential location for a replacement building. The Township has existing land adjacent to the present building. The present building is being paid off 14 years early (on a 30 year loan), so will no longer be on your winter tax bill. On August 2, 2022 we will be putting on the ballot a new millage to cover costs for the new building, which would be .89 mills, which would be an increase of approximately \$13.00 a year on a taxable value of \$47,000.00. The Township has received some ARPA funds from the US Department of Treasury to help with professional services for this project. Cleon Township Fire Department services the Village of Copemish, Cleon Township, neighboring Springdale Township and as mutual aid to several surrounding communities. A reminder of other August Ballot Issues

Manistee County has a proposal to allow the Townships their full 1.5 Mills to be voted on August 2, 2022 and there will be renewals for Cleon Township Cemetery and Fire Department-millages. These are a renewal of the existing mills for 5 years.

Manisteee County also has a renewal of the 911/Central Dispatch and the Manistee County Conservation District has a renewal also with additional millage.



those taxpayers who have a mortgage company or bank paying your taxes (escrow), you will see a pink sticker on your tax bill that says a copy of the bill was sent to your Mortgage Company but the original is being sent to you. You may mail your payment or pay in person, or there is a drop box in the door of the Township Hall. If you would like a receipt mailed, please send a self addressed stamped envelope. Summer taxes are due July 1 thru September 14th. After September 14, a 1% per month will be added to the unpaid base amount until March 1, 2023.
