Summer Tax Deferment...

Some taxpayers may be eligible for a summer tax deferment, which means you can defer the interest and penalty on your taxes until February 14, 2024. If you are a Sr. citizen (62 years and older), paraplegic, quadriplegic, eligible widow, blind person, or totally disabled and your household income does not exceed \$40,000.00 a year, you may qualify. If you qualify, stop by and pick up an application or call and one will be mailed to you.

From The Treasurer... Summer taxes are due July 1 thru September 14 without penalty. After September 14, a 1% per month or part thereof will be added to the unpaid base amount until March 1, 2024. At that time they will be turned over to the Manistee County Treasurer as delinquent and you will have to pay the County, with penalties. You may pay your summer taxes by mail, or I am at the Township offices on Thursday evenings from 6-8 PM and Fridays from 10:00 AM-4:00 PM. You may leave a message on the answering machine at 231 378-2616 and I will return your call.

For those of you who have a mortgage company or bank paying your taxes (escrow), you will see a pink sticker on your tax bill that says a copy of the bill was sent to your Mortgage Company but the original is being sent to you. For those who pay their taxes by mail, keep the bottom part of your tax bill as a receipt or if you would like a receipt mailed, please send a self addressed stamped envelope.

2023 Manistee County Plat Books are available at the Manistee County 4H Advisory Council at 395 Third St Manistee 49660 or from the Manistee County Treasurers office. Cost is \$38.00 which includes sales tax and postage. There is an insert with your tax bill if you are interested in purchasing.
