1. Report on Staging Area/Trailhead at Copemish

Linda Cudney and Dave Myers from Cleon Township, Elaine Gibbs and Shannon Saunders from the Village of Copemish, Rob Carson, from Networks Northwest, Scott Slavin from the DNR and Joseph Williams and Shane Gamrat from Gourdie Frasier and Associates met on Friday, July 29, 2023 in the Village of Copemish to discuss the trailhead in Copemish. It was decided on the suggestion by Scott Slavin to put it off of Front Street almost across from the Village park, where there will be water, bathrooms, etc. There was some discussion of a trail/road/shortcut from M-115 into the Village, but in checking with the Township Assessor, and Equalization, there was a correction in the tax maps and description to show that the whole trail is owned by the DNR.

2. EDA Update

Rob reported that the survey has been done. The preliminary bids for the bridge over Bear Creek came in considerably lower than originally thought. Working on permits to be done and construction bids to come in. The bridge will be built off site and hauled in.

1. Recreation Commission Update

Katie Mehl and Sara Herberger asked the Recreation Commission to establish their plans for the Chief and Kaleva trailheads. With this, they can start applying for the Minger grant which can help with engineering studies, as the deadline for the Minger grant is October 2, 2023. From there a grant can be applied for from the State. There was discussion to include the whole trail from Thompsonville to Kaleva.

There is a vacancy on the Recreation Commission to replace Mr Dunlop. It was posted by the County Administrators office.

Meg Batzer updated the Recreation Commission on the work that was done after the diesel spill in Lake Michigan.

2. Marketing Committee Update

3. Other discussion include the US Forest Service and keeping them informed and possibly focus on Big M improvements and also support for more loop backpacking trails on USFS lands.
